## **What is a docent?**

Docents are volunteer educators who engage adult and school groups in an active exploration of culture.

## **Commitment**

Volunteer candidates must commit to a 9-month program as a provisional docent. After the training program, active docents make a minimum 1-year commitment to the program.

## **Training**

IMC orientation and training occurs once a year for a duration of nine months. Continuing education is provided six times a year. Docents learn about IMC's collection, special exhibitions, topics, tour development, and tour techniques.
